AT IBM PULSE CONFERENCE IN LAS VEGAS**

Prolifics' Autonomic Monitoring Platform (AMP) provides an intelligence-based monitoring platform that will eliminate common problems and reduce much of the guesswork when diagnosing bottlenecks for its customers. AMP enables organizations to prevent problems before users report them, identify most probable fixes, and automates resolution for common problems. The three key elements of this new and innovative platform are 1) Self-Identification, 2) Self-Diagnosing and 3) Self-Healing.

Self-Identification includes monitoring performance problems and essential application resources while displaying all single/in-flight request details. It also includes providing notifications based on alerts, thresholds, failures and custom events.

Self-Diagnosis includes performing analysis of memory leaks, performance, SQL, etc. and determining sources of bottlenecks. In addition, it enables in-flight request diagnostics with real-time transaction tracing, log monitoring and event correlation.

Self-Healing includes leveraging a comprehensive knowledge base repository of over 4,000+ common problems and resolutions that assist in automatically correcting problems before or while they are happening. The repository and automation is further extended based on custom environments and types of common issues. Additionally, the AMP can stop, restart or change configurations or initiate failover automatically for various components.
